Eruv Tavshilin Checklist

1. Set aside two foods: one cooked (like an egg) and one baked (like a sheet of matzah).
2. Hold the items and make the bracha "al mitzvat eruv" and then the statement: בד"ן יהא שרי לן לאפויי ולבשולי ולאטמוני ולאדלוקי שרגא ולמעבד כל צרכנא מיום טוב לשבת, meaning, "With this Eruv it should be permitted for us to bake, cook, insulate food, light a candle, and do any need from Yom Tov for Shabbat". One must understand what they are saying, so say it in English if you're not a great Aramaic speaker.
3. One should attempt to complete the cooking on Yom Tov rather than have it go into Shabbat (so start the cholent early on Friday).
4. Some have the custom eat the Eruv Tavshilin at Seudah Shlishit on Shabbat.

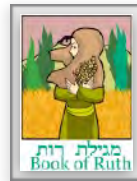

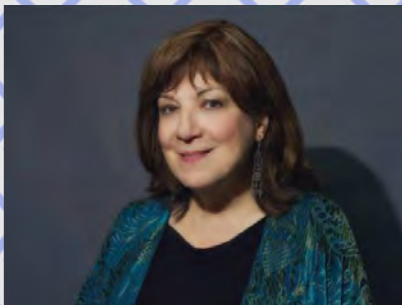
