#### A MESSAGE FROM THE RABBI

Dear Kehillat Kodesh (קייק) Congregation Ahavat Achim,

We are blessed this year to be honoring a couple so deserving of our appreciation, Joanne and Stu Oppenheim.

There is no ritual performance in Jewish life that requires as much advanced preparation and is as crucial to the normative Jewish life than leining. Reading Torah stands alone at the nexus of necessity and difficulty. Therefore, when one of the honorees is the *Baal Korei*, it is an opportunity to discuss the mitzvah of preparation as it pertains to Shabbat, namely, Kavod (*honoring*) Shabbat and it's partner, Oneg (*enjoying*) Shabbat.

These two mitzvot are the two primary modalities of our positive obligation for relating to Shabbat and they are derived from a single verse in Isaiah (58: 13) אָם־תָּשָׁיב מִשַּׁבָּת רַגְלֶּךְ צְשִׂוֹת חֲפָצֶךְ בְּיִוֹם קְדְשֵׁי וְקָרָאתָ לַשַּׁבְּת עֹנֶג לִקְדְוֹשׁ ה׳ מְבֶּבֶּד וְכִבַּדְתוֹ מִשְׁיָב מִשְּׁבָּת רַבְּלֶד וְדַבֶּר דְּבֵר דְּבֵר דְּבֵר דְּבֵר דְּבָר:

If you refrain from trampling the sabbath, from pursuing your affairs on My holy day; If you call the sabbath "delight," the LORD's holy day "honored"; and if you honor it and go not your ways Nor look to your affairs, nor strike bargains— [the next verse continues that then God will delight in us and allow us to thrive in the land of Israel].

Maimonides (Shabbat 30: 2) in assessing these mitzvot asks "What is *Kavod Shabbat*:" and explains, שֶׁאָמְרוּ חֲכָמִים שֶׁמִּצְוָה עַל אָדָם לְרְחֹץ פָּנָיו יָדָיו וְרַגְלָיו בְּחַמִּין מְּמְצָוָה עַל אָדָם לְרְחֹץ פָּנִי יִדְיו וְרַגְלָיו בְּחַמִּין לְהַקְבָּלַת פְּנֵי הַשַּׁבָּת פְּנֵי הַשַּׁבָּת מְפְּנֵי כְּבוֹד הַשַּׁבָּת וּמִתְעַטֵּף בְּצִיצִית וְיוֹשֵׁב בְּכֹבֶד רֹאשׁ מְיַחֵל לְהַקְבָּלַת פְּנֵי הַשַּׁבְּת פְּנֵי הַשַּׁבָּת מְפְנֵי כְּבוֹד הַשַּׁבָּת וֹמְתְעַטֵּף בְּצִיצִית וְיוֹשֵׁב בְּכֹבֶד רֹאשׁ מְיַחֵל לְהַקְבָּלַת פְּנֵי הַשַּׁבְּת הַמְּלֶּדְ *The sages explained this by declaring that each person should wash his face, hands and feet with hot water on Friday in honor of the Sabbath, and then enwrap himself in a fringed garment and be seated with dignity in expectation of the Sabbath, receiving it as if he were coming out to meet the king.* 



The emphasis when it comes to the mitzvah of *Kavod Shabbat* – dignifying and designating the importance of the day comes via preparation. Cleaning ones self, ones clothes, making the necessary arrangements so that Shabbat will feel like a glorified rather than a deprived day. Since we cannot prepare on the Shabbat itself, we must prepare in advance.

In discussing the laws of reading Torah, the *Shulchan Aruch* explicitly mentions that one must prepare before reading. To bring *Kavod LaTorah* (honor to Torah) the reader must be prepared to read fluidly, thus the Torah is not just taught and read, but performed in away that shows reverence.

When asked about the influence that Joanne had on the religious upbringing and environment in the home, Oren immediately noted the preparation that Joanne engaged and continues to engage in to "make Shabbat feel special".

Joanne and Stu embody this notion of *Kavod*, in dignifying the mitzvot of Shabbat and Torah by their preparation. As if that weren't enough, we all get to benefit from their immense preparation when they run a trivia night and we're looking forward to the next one!

The other positive commandment associated with Shabbat listed in the above verse is *Oneg* (enjoying) Shabbat. Here again, Stu and Joanne's focus on creating environment that nurture and enjoyment and love of mitzvot is clear. From the dedication of Joanne as the most regular female outdoor minyan attendee during COVID to the welcoming atmosphere Stu created and maintains at the *Hashkama* minyan, Stu and Joanne embody and imbue an *Oneg* in *Mitvah* fulfillment and making Judaism immersive and joyous.

May Stu and Joanne continue to enhance their own, their family's, and our community's immersion and joy in serving Hashem via the devout preparation they dedicate themselves to.
