#### הושענא רבה/ערב שמיני עצרת HOSHANA RABBAH/EREV SHEMINI ATZERET

Many extra prayers are added to the service on Hoshana Rabba as the judgment concerning the fate of our water supply is finalized, and the conclusion of any period of judgement is our last chance to influence the Divine Judgement. When we get to "תענה" during Hashanos we put the Four Species down and we take the special Aravot of Hoshana Rabba (the custom is to take five stems that are bound together) into our hands (anything that invalidates the Arovot of the Four Species during Succot invalidates these Arovot on Hoshana Rabba); at the end of the Hoshanos we beat the Arovot against the floor five times according to custom. As with every Erev Yom Tov, we bathe (many immerse in a Mikveh), and make preparations in honor of Yom Tov. It is customary for candles to be lit in the Succah with Brachot "טובר" and "שהחיינו" and "נום טוב"

#### שמיני עצרת - SHEMINI ATZERET

It is customary to make the Yom Tov Kiddush, with שהחיינו, in the Succah; however, we do not make the Bracha "לישב בסוכה", and we eat in the Succah both the night and day of Shemini Atzeret, again, without making the Bracha "לישב בסוכה. During Yizkor, we make pledges to Tzedakah as a means of elevating the souls of the departed. The Shammash announces "הגשם משיב הרוח ומוריד" before the congregation begins the silent Shemonah Esrei of Mussaf, so that the congregation will add it in their silent Shemonah Esrei. From then, if one forgot to say "משיב הרוח" but remembered before he began "אתה קדוש" then he may say "משיב הרוח" (Geshem).

#### - שמחת תורה SIMCHAT TORAH

Prior to Maariv we auction "אתה הראת" and other honors of Simchat Torah such as Chatan Torah, Chatan Breishit & "כל". Remember that one should refrain from wanton foolishness and levity, but rather one should engage only in celebration that is for the sake of Heaven.

#### **DISPOSAL OF LULAV & ETROG**

You may dispose of a Lulav in any way that is not degrading. For example, you may drop it into a field or put it on a lawn, unless animals might eat it or step on it or if it will be subject to poor treatment before it decays. Don't dispose of a lulav or etrog directly into the garbage. Burn, bury, or wrap them in a bag or one layer of plastic and then you may throw it into normal garbage.
